The incident took place at the village of the district. Due to heavy rain, the house collapsed, resulting in the death of the two children and injuries to five others. SHO Rajni Lal said.

ED raid

■ Thiruvananthapuram: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) on Monday carried out raids at the institutions of the Church of South India (CSI) over corruption allegations at its Kaniyamkulam medical college. The ED raided the headquarters of the CSI South Kerala division which houses the office of Bishop, A Dharmaraj Rasalan, here.

Captured

■ Saharanpur: A leopard, which had entered a university here, was captured by the forest department team on Monday. Superintendent of Police (Rural) Suraj said that the animal had entered Glocal University, adding that the incident had spread panic among the students.

CBI arrests

■ New Delhi: The CBI has arrested seven people in connection with the murder of a man in May last year during the incidents of violence that broke out after the West Bengal assembly elections, officials said on Monday. Accused Pranab Barik, Pritam Roy Sarkar, Ratan Roy Sarkar, Litan Ghil, Litan Bhaskar, Nakul Roy Sarkar and Biswaji Barman were arrested from Cooch Behar, Jaipur and Kolkata after sustained surveillance, they said.

Special mass

■ Kolkata: A special mass was organised at the Cathedral of the Most Holy Rosary in Burrabazar area of Kolkata to pray for communal harmony and spread the message of humanity and peace. The event was organised on Sunday by the Vatican Nuncio to India and Nepal, Archbishop Leopoldo Gillies, and Cardinal Charles Maung Bo, president of the Federation of Asian Bishops' Conferences, Myanmar.

Murmu takes oath as 15th Prez of India

New Delhi, Jul 25 (PTI)

Droupadi Murmu on Monday took oath as the 15th President of India. N V Ramana administered her oath at a ceremony held at Parliament Central Hall in the presence of former president Ram Nath Kovind, Vice President and Rajya Sabha Chairman M Venkaiah Naidu and Prime Minister Narendra Modi among others.

She took the oath in the name of God in Hindi. Hailing from the Santhal community, Murmu is the first tribal leader to assume the office of the President.

Former President Pratibha Patil, and Chief Ministers Naveen Patnaik, Ekamath, Yogi Adityanath and N Biren Singh were among the dignitaries present. Dressed in a white saree

with green and red border. Murmu took the oath of office in the name of God in Hindi to 'preserve, protect and defend the Constitution and the law'. Murmu was given a 21 gun salute after which she signed the oath register amid a thunderous applause and thumping of desks. The oath taking ceremony was marked by

'My election proves poor Indians can also fulfil aspirations'

President Droupadi Murmu said on Monday that her election to the country's top constitutional position is not her personal achievement but that of India's every poor person as it shows that he can dream but also fulfil those aspirations. In her acceptance speech after taking oath as India's 15th President, the 64-year-old Murmu said the country's deprived, poor, Dalits and tribals can see their reflection in her which, she added, is a matter of big satisfaction for India's freedom fighters, and said the country will have to move quickly on the two tracks of "sabka prays" (everybody's effort) and "sabka kalyan" (everybody's duty) to fulfil their aspirations. Noting that she was born after independence, Murmu said it was her good fortune that she has assumed the position at a time when the country is celebrating its 75th anniversary of its freedom.

After a national salute by the President's Bodyguard at Gate No 6 of the Parliament, the new President and her predecessor left in a ceremonial procession to the Rashtrapati Bhavan to the Parliament building.

After the short ceremony, Murmu and Kovind were escorted out of the Central Hall amid the roll of drums and blowing of trumpets

Naxals set afire two vehicles, machine used for laying telecom cables

Bilaspur Jul 25

Naxals set afire two vehicles and a machine engaged in laying cables of a private telecom company in Bilaspur district, police said on Monday. The incident which took place on Sunday evening between Parda and Kakakorma villages under Bilaspur police station limits where the cable laying work was going on. Additional Superintendent of Police Pankaj Shukla said a group of armed ultra-terrorists used the machine and threatened labourers to stop the work, he said.

The rebels then set on fire an earth-excavating machine and two private vehicles, the official said. No one was injured in the incident, he said. The police have registered a case under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code and further probe is on, he added. There have been several incidents in the past also, where Naxals tried to disrupt development works, including road construction, in various parts of the state by launching attacks on security forces and damaging roads, vehicles and machines used in the work.

About the incident

The incident took place on Sunday evening between Parda and Kakakorma villages under Bilaspur police station limits where the cable laying work was going on. A group of armed ultra-terrorists used the machine and threatened labourers to stop the work, he said.

Sonia's second round of ED questioning today

New Delhi: Congress President Sonia Gandhi is expected to appear before the Enforcement Directorate (ED) today for her second round of questioning in the money laundering case linked to the national merger scheme for the telecom sector before the Indian probe agency around 10.30 am on July 26 for more than 12 hours. ED investigating officer, officials said. Initially, she was summoned by the agency on Monday but it was delayed by a day. The 57-year-old Gandhi was questioned for over two hours during her first day of questioning in the case on July 25, where she replied to 23 questions put forth by the agency, that a pending alleged financial irregularities in the Congress-promoted housing India Private Limited, which owns the National Herald newspaper.

Scammers sold governorships, RS seats for Rs 100 cr!

New Delhi, Jul 25 (PTI)

The CBI has busted a multi-state racket of impostors and arrested four of them for allegedly attempting to cheat people of Rs 100 crore worth promises of Rajya Sabha seats and governorship of officials said.

The agency had conducted searches recently in connection with the case, and four members of the gang were arrested, they said.

One of the accused fled during the search operation after assaulting CBI officers, the officials said.

A separate FIR has been filed against him in the local police station for assaulting agency officials, they said. In its FIR, the CBI has named Kamalakar Premkumar Bangdar of Maharashtra's Latur, Ravindra Vithal Naik of Karnataka's Belgaum, and Delhi-NCR-based Mahendra Pal Arora, Abhishek Bora and Mohammed Aijaz Khan in connection with the case, the officials said.

It is alleged that Bangdar is posing as a senior CBI officer and flaunting his "connections" with highly placed officials and had asked Bora, Arora, Khan and Naik to bring any sort of work that he could fix in lieu of payment of huge illegal gratification.

CBI busts racket

They conspired with "the sole ulterior motive of cheating private persons by falsely assuring them for arrangement of seats in Rajya Sabha, appointment as governor or appointment as chairman in different government-run or organisations under central government ministries and departments against huge pecuniary consideration," the FIR alleged.

The agency came to know through its source that Bora conspired with Bangdar how the latter's purported connection with high-ranking officials who play "pivotal roles" in appointments be exploited to get the work done.

'Extremely radicalised' youth from Assam arrested in Bengaluru

Bengaluru, Jul 25 (PTI)

An "extremely radicalised" youth from Assam has been arrested here by the Central Crime Branch of Bengaluru and police say an investigation was on to find out if he has links with any terrorist outfit.

Akhbar Hussain Lashkar, who was working as a food delivery executive, was picked up on Sunday night from a rented flat on the third floor of an apartment in Tilaknagar where he was living with some other people belonging to the same profession.

Home Minister Araga Jnanendra said on Monday the police have

also detained his "accomplices" for questioning. Police sources said Lashkar has been booked under various sections of Indian Penal Code, including one for waging a war against the Government of India.

"He's an extremely radicalised youth. We worked out together with various agencies.

He has been arrested and a case has been registered against him. The investigation and interrogation is on to unearth whether (he had links) with any of the organisations," Bengaluru Police Commissioner C H Fratap Reddy told reporters. "He was working as a delivery boy

Four Cong MPs suspended from LS for rest of session

Four Congress Lok Sabha members were suspended for the rest of the session on Monday after Speaker Om Birla took a stern view of the continuous disruptions by opposition MPs since the beginning of the Monsoon Session. As the protesting opposition members again stalled proceedings on Monday, the Chair named Congress MPs Manickam Tagore, TN Prathapan, Jothamani and Ramya Haridas after being suspended for the rest of the session for allegedly disrupting proceedings in the Lok Sabha during ongoing Monsoon Session of Parliament, in New Delhi, Monday.

For disrupting proceedings

Monday, the Chair named Congress MPs Manickam Tagore, TN Prathapan, Jothamani and Ramya Haridas. When a member named, he or she has to immediately withdraw from the chamber of the House. Parliamentary Affairs Minister Pralhad Joshi then moved a resolution to suspend the four for the rest of the session. Joshi said that these MPs had shown "utter disregard" for the authority of the Chair and a "serious note of their misconduct" had been taken by the House.

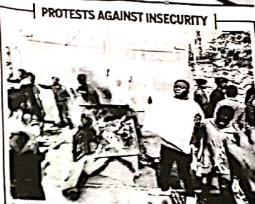
